(1) ... Mathew 5:3

Blessed are the poor in Spirit. Not egotistical, not proud, not boastful, not argumentive. Gal. 6:3 and Romans 12:3.

(2)...Verse 4

Blessed are they that mourn now...dissatisfied with present wrongs, and lack of salvation. _Ezek. 9:4 and 13:22.

(3)...Verse 5

Blessed are the meek...They will not fight back, or avenge themselves. Will not grab for self. Will not push ahead of others. I Cor. 13:4-7.

(4)...Verse 6

Blessed are they that hunger and thirst after righteousness. Have earnest desire to know exactly how God wants things. Prov. 23:15,16...opposite of Jer. 9:3.

(5)...Verse 7

Blessed are the merciful. Love to see others recover themselves from mistakes. II Tim. 2:25 & James 2:13.

(6)...Verse 8

Blessed are the pure in heart. Genuinely enjoy being holy and harmless. Prov. 4:23 16:1 18:15 22:11.

(7)...Blessed are the peacemakers. James 3:17,18. Opposite of James 4:1-5.

(8)...Verse 10

Blessed are they who are persecuted for righteousness. Gen. 4:8 Acts 7:52 Gal. 4:29 Heb. 11:35-40.

(9) ... Verse 11

Blessed are ye when reviled, persecuted and evil spoken of for His Name's sake. Speak up; show the example and don't change regardless of opposition. Acts 5:29.

(10)...Verse 12

Rejoice, because you are counted worthy to suffer for His Name's sake. Acts 5:40,41.

(11)...verse 13

Ye are the salt of the earth. Live carefully; keep the quality that will influence people to do right. I Tim. 4:16 Rom. 2:23,24.

(12)... Verse 14

Ye are the light of the world. As the sun is to the natural earth, so are you to it's people. They can only see the right by the example you live. Phil. 2:15.

(13)... Terse 15

Men do not light a light to hide it. The Lord gives knowledge to His people to give direction to those seeking the way. Jer. 23:28.

(17)...Verse 20

Never settle for being "just as good" as some one who seems to be getting by alright. II. Cor. 10:12 Math. 25:2,3.

(18)...Verses 21, 22

Don't be angry without just cause, then don't let your anger cause you to sin. Eph. 4:26 Titus 1:7 Prov. 29:22 and Psa. 37:8.

(19)...Verse 22

Watch your tongue concerning your brother. James 4:11,12 Romand 14:4 James 3:5-12.

(20)...Verses 23,24

Don't expect God to hear you or accept you, when you are at odds with another child of God, especially if it is your fault. I Cor. 11:29,30 Isa. 1:15.

(21)...Verses 25,26

Get your differences settled before God has to take a hand in the matter, for God will surely punish the guilty. Deut. 32:35 Psa. 94:1 Heb. 10:30 (Ck. vengence" from conc)

(2?)...Verses 27,28

The eye and the heart work together. Eccl. 1:8 Isa. 42:

20. But you can keep your heart from following your eyes.

(23)...Verse 29

Ministers have the responsibility to police the Ministry. If a minister will not do right, then the rest should deal with him according to Gal. 6:1 Matt. 18:15-17. Even though he may be greatest among them. Rom. 16:17.

(24)...Verse 30

Ministers have the responsibility of those they appoint over any work, and should remove them immediately if they cause reproach. I Tim. 3:10 III John 9-11.

(25)... Verses 31,32

God hates divorce. Mal. 2:16 I Cor. 7:10-17.

(26)...Verses 35-37

Don't bind yourself with an oath. Do right without an oath. Refuse to do wrong and your word will be better than an oath. Ecc. 5:5 I Tim. 4:12 James 5:12.

(27)...Verses 38, 39

Don't fight back, take wrong and work for right; even the salvation of those who do you wrong. Rom. 12:17, 20,21. I Thess. 5:15.

(28)...Verse 40

Give in rather than go to court before the unbelievers. Consider what damage to the cause of God can be done by the airing of Christian's grievances publicly. I Cor. 6:1-8. It is better to unjustly lose one's possessions than the gospel be blasphemed. Give it up for the Gospel's sake and God will reward 100 fold. Mark 10:29-30 Luke 18:28,29.

(29)...Verse 41

Don't be stubborn, be agreeable. Go out of your way to be friendly. Don't separate over trifles. Eph. 4:3 and I Cor. 13:4.

(30)... Verse 42

Give whenever needed, especially when asked by the one in need. Prov. 3:27 Psa. 112:9.

(31)...Verse 42

Loan willingly, even be willing to make it a gift rather than a loan. Psa. 37:21.

(32)... Verses 43,44

Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, pray for them that despitefully use you. Rom. 12:14-20 Acts 7:60.

(33<u>)...</u>Terse 45

Remember, God does good for the whole world. He wants His children to be like Him. Acts 14:16,17.

(34)...Verses 46,47

Remember, kind likes kind in the world, Isa. 65:11 I Tim. 2:4.

(35)...Verse 48

Don't act like children. God does not stoop to men's level. Be matured. Eph. 4:14 I Cor. 14:20.

(36)...Math. 6:1-8

Don't give or pray to be seen, (not to be acknowledged.) I Cor. 13:4. (Vaunteth not it'self.)

(37)...Verses 9-13

Pray for the fulfillment of God's will, and for your development in God. Eph. 6:18-19.

(38)...Verses 14,15

Remember to forgive others, as your forgiveness depends on it. James 2:13 Math. 18:23-25.

(39)... Terses 16-18

Fast and pray in secret. God will reward in due season. (But not always as we might think, perhaps in a more profitable manner. Eph. 3:20.

(40)...Verses 19-21

Let heavenly things be your treasure. Psa. 19:10 Rev. 2:9 and 3:17,18.

(41)... Verses 22,23

The light of the body, (Body of Christ) is the eye (the Ministry) As a minister, have singleness of heart to do all things God's way. I Cor. 1:10 Acts 2:1 Luke 11:34-36.

(42)...Verses 24-34

You can't serve God if you compromise for your own personal welfare. I Sa. 8:3 I Tim. 3:3,8 Titus 1:7,11 & I Pet. 5:2 I Tim. 6:9,10.

(43)...Math. 7:1,2

You will be judged by the standards you impose on others. Romans 2:1-3.

(44)...Verses 2-5

Get your own life in subjection to God before judging other's faults. Romans 2:8,9.

(45)...Verse 6

The things of God are sacred. Don't give them to men who would use them against God. II Kings 20:12-18.

(46)...Ask, seek, and knock, untill
you reach perfection.
1...ask for the Holy Ghost,
2...Seek for knowledge,
3...knock for an entrance into
the grace to stand forever.
