THE BODY OF CHRIST has no earthly headquarters! All denominations have headquarters in a physical, tangible city that make decisions for their particular organization. They have become political arenas for ministers and priests alike jockeying for higher positions within the organizations.

GOD DID NOT give the church over to a man, or an organization, but to JESUS! Therefore, there is to be no physical head - elected or assumed - over the BODY OF CHRIST. Jesus is the federal head of the Church. He is the head of every man, I Corinthians. 11:3.

Denominations would have us believe that all we have to do is join their organizations, pay our tithes, and heaven will be our home. Jesus, however, is compelling us to come up higher, love God with all our heart, quit the sinning business, and love our brother as ourselves.

Since denominations are not concerned with spiritual growth, maturity, or perfection, saints remain babes in Christ.

	THE TOWER OF BABEL The first religious edifice
	NIMROD, through his own ingenuity, tried to build a church in Babel that would reach into the heavens naming it the Tower of Babel. This massive operation required the support of the civil government with Nimrod as the hierarch. Today is the same. Many religious men, like Nimrod, have built mammoth names unto themselves, towers supposedly reaching into the sky to save the lost. Like the Tower of Babel, however, these towers also will end in confusion and division.

LIKE THE BABELITES, the Holiness people at the turn of this century felt it necessary to organize for their protection and unity. Instead of unity, however, this always eventuates in confusion.

### THE MARK

NIMROD WAS THE founder of false religion. In his day there was but one language (doctrine). He used brick for stone, and slime for mortar (Genesis 11:3). The foundation for true religion, however, must be Christ, built with Lively Stones, not brick. Love must hold it together instead of slime.

Brick are rectangular, uniform (in size and color) blocks of clay burned in a kiln. Each plant stamps, or MARKS, the brick.

NIMROD POLLUTED the Tower of Babel with brick. Man desires to build everything precise. They operate their church services to please themselves rather than pleasing God. Building a church of human endeavors without God's blessings can only result in total destruction.

THERE HAVE BEEN many minor changes made over the years in the church, such as dress. With robes and sandals antiquated (old fashioned), we dress different today than they did in Bible days. The doctrine (or foundation) of Christ, however, remains the same to every generation.

Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire;

and the \_\_\_\_\_ shall try every man's work of what sort it is.

Jesus said to Peter, Upon this rock I will build MY CHURCH. Some feel that Jesus was referring to Peter - that Peter was the Rock that the Church (the Body of Christ) was to be founded on. Peter, however, back-slid soon after this and went back to cursing like he did in the old-days. And again, in Galatians 2:11, Paul withstood Peter to his face before them all, because He was to be blamed. (Peter had refused to eat with the Gentiles.) So Peter can not be that foundation - Jesus is the ROCK upon which the Church is to be built!

The Church must measure up, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ, Ephesians 4:13. Anything less than this will result in total disaster, and confusion.

ORGANIZING THE CHURCH, putting a preacher in charge, is like putting a rudder on the Ark. God gave Noah specific instructions to build the Ark. And it didn't include a rudder. For Noah (man) could have then controlled the Ark. You see, God wanted to control the big ship (the Church). God wanted complete command to guide Noah and his family where He, God, wanted them to go. And because God wants us only to look up toward Him, He told Noah to place the window in the top of the Ark. And why was the door in the side? As the Soldiers pierced Jesus' side, blood (His Spirit) and water (baptism) came out. Therefore the only way we can get in Christ is by being born again by His Spirit and being baptized in water. This is the beginning of the qualifications to be in the Bride of Christ.

Again, the Lord opened Adam's side, took one of his ribs, and made a woman. She became his bride and help meet, to help rule the world. This is a picture of Christ and His Bride ruling and reigning over the earth for the next thousand years.

### THE BRIDE WILL RULE WITH CHRIST




IF A MINISTER carries a license, he has been ordained by man, not God! His authority to preach is from man, not God. However, when God calls a man to the ministry, this is authority enough. A license is not needed. When a minister receives a license, his 'head' becomes those who issue the license. And, since they are your authority, they also can control what and how you preach. What you are saying to God when you take a license, then, is His authority is not enough.

Aaron was called of God to the ministry. Peter, James, and John were called of God to the ministry. And like Noah, every minister's authority must come from Jesus. Why? Because JESUS is the Head of the Church, His BODY.

Shakespeare put it like this, Violent delights have violent ends. And so goes the story of Balaam.





### **CHAPTER III**

To please God, we must take the time to walk with Him and develop a relationship with Him. William Law wrote, Devotion signifies a life given, or devoted to God. He therefore is the devout (godly) man, who lives no longer to his own will, or the way and spirit of the world, but to the sole will of God, who considers God in everything, who serves God in everything, who makes all the parts of his common life, parts of piety (godliness), by doing everything in the name of God, and under such rules as are conformable to His Glory.





AGABUS, a prophet from Judaea, took Paul's belt and tied his hands and feet. He said, So shall the Jews at Jerusalem bind the man that owneth this belt, and shall deliver him into the hands of the Gentiles. Paul, unwilling to be detoured from his mission, relentlessly replied that he was not only willing to be bound, but also to die if necessary. Acts 21:14:14.

ANANIAS was led by the Spirit to go and pray for one called Saul of Tarsus. He did so against his will. (The church of that time was in great fear of Paul.) Acts 9.

CORNELIUS, a Gentile, was led by the Spirit to send for Peter, a Jew, to come to tell them all things what they should do. Although skeptical, Cornelius obeyed. With trepidation, fearing the Jews, Peter went against his will. Acts 10.

PAUL, being led by the Spirit to Macedonia, left 'immediately.' Acts 16:9,10.

WHAT KIND OF book would the book of Acts be if these men had not been willing to be led by the Spirit, even against their own will?



### SUBSEQUENT TO THE NEW TESTAMENT

JOHN WYCLIF, WILLIAM TYNDALE (who was strangled and then his body burned at the stake), MILES COVERDALE, and many others were led by the Spirit to translate the Bible into a language the common people could read.

MARTIN LUTHER, led by the Spirit on October 31, 1517, tacked to the door of the Schlosskirche (castle church) in Wittenberg 95 academic theses On the Power of Indulgences, hoping that some scholar would debate with him about the relation of indulgences to penance, but instead of a debate, this brought about the beginning of the Great Reformation of the Church.

JOHN AND CHARLES WESLEY, were led by the Spirit to separate themselves from the Church of England. They and their followers were called *The Holy Club* because of their very strict and orderly lives.

THERE WERE many more who gave their lives for the Gospel's sake, dedicating themselves totally to our Lord.

AT THE TURN of this century, God made another great move. People once again got serious with God and began asking the same question that was asked Peter on the day of Pentecost. Men and brethren, what shall we do? And just like the day of Pentecost, people began speaking in tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance.

THIS NEW movement began to grow. At first they only asked, "Have you received the Holy Ghost since you believed?" But after a few years, they began separating over doctrine and asked, "What do you believe since you received." They looked back, then, to their Mother Church for answers and decided they needed to organize like all the other Christian Churches and they began to separate.

In 1914, BRO. WILLIAM SOWDERS, a young Pentecostal preacher, was invited to the meeting where this decision of organizing the Pentecostal church took place. The night before he was to leave for this meeting, God gave Bro. Sowders a dream warning him against going to that meeting. Bro. Sowders was LED BY THE SPIRIT to gather all of God's people together, no matter what they believed, With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love; endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace, Ephesians 4:2,3.

### HOW SHOULD A CHURCH SERVICE BE CONDUCTED?

IN MOST CHURCHES today the saints may not express themselves or the Spirit they feel in their church services. Preachers are the whole show. This cannot be the Body of Christ! For the Apostle Paul asked,

ICorinthians. 14:26 How is it then, brethren? when ye come together, \_\_\_\_\_\_ ONE of you hath a psalm, hath a doctrine, hath a tongue, hath a revelation, hath an interpretation. Let all things be done unto edifying.

WHEN WE COME together, everyone, including the preacher, is to be led by the Spirit. God gives to each saint a gift to exhort, to edify, and to minister to each other the fullness of God.

BROTHER CLYDE PATTON has told this story many times. One night Brother Coruthers, a Pentecostal preacher from the early part of this century, was praying about the church. The Lord spoke to him and said, "My people are not the saved people." Bro. Coruthers said, "Yes, Lord, I understand there is a deeper walk with you." The Lord continued, "My people are not the Holy Ghost people." Brother Coruthers became puzzled and asked the Lord for permission to go to the other room so he could write this down. The Lord permitted it, then He continued, "My people are the SPIRIT LED PEOPLE!"

Brother Sowders would say, "WATCH THE SPIRIT!" These men of God have emphatically emphasized the importance of preachers taking their hands off a church service; for unless they do, God will not be able to work.

Most of our trials are brought about by our brothers and sisters in the Lord. Someone steps on our toes and we are quick to let everyone know that we have been done wrong. We become real cry babies. However, the birth stone of the Body of Christ is the GRIND STONE.

In the Old Testament they had two circular stones in which to grind any edible grain into flour. The lower one had a stout stick standing at it center, and the upper one had a hole at its center so that it could rotate around the stick, and a handle eight or ten inches from the center to turn it. Generally it was worked by two women, facing each other, and each grasping the handle to turn the rider. One woman fed the grain in at the center of the upper stone and the other would guide and brush the products into a little pile. Because men depended upon flour for the staff of life and because they generally ground it only as needed, it was forbidden to take a mill in pledge.





#### **CHAPTER VI**

IF WE ARE to understand and recognize The Body of Christ, we must first see God's nature. Out of His nature springs the deeds God performs, what God likes, and what God dislikes.

When Jesus came He did not only reveal God's righteousness, God's Holiness, and God's power, but He also revealed God's nature. This is God's identity, the embodiment of God that gives understanding to God's peculiarity in His people. For Jesus came in the brightness of God's glory and in the express image of God's person. And by the power of God's Word, He purges our sins. For in Him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily, (see Hebrews 1:1-4, & Colossians 2:9). So Jesus was the embodiment of God. Yes, God's righteousness and Holiness and power. So it is with the Church. The Church is to be in the image of Christ as Christ is in the image of His Father.

The world is trying to see the Body of Christ through a filter. (The filter being their own inadequate understanding of what God likes and dislikes). This filter befogs a person's vision like pure sunlight shinning through a dirty glass. The Problem here is that the obscurity brought about by the filter is our own product. Unfortunately, our nature and God's nature are running in opposite directions.

## WHAT DOES HOLINESS DO FOR US?

TO RESIST TEMPTATION is to be holy, i.e., to be morally blameless. It is to be separated from sin and consecrated to God. To pursue Holiness and face temptation takes effort and diligence and is a lifelong task. As we begin to conform to the will of God in one area, He will reveal to us our needs in another area. Thus, we begin to mature in Him.

#### THE PURSUIT OF HOLINESS

THERE ARE THREE basic problems, however, that come against us in our pursuit of Holiness:



(1) Our attitude toward sin and temptation may be more selfcentered than God-centered. We become more concerned about our own "victory" over sin than about our sins grieving the heart of God. God wants us to walk in obedience - not victory.



(2) We may have misunderstood living by faith to mean that no effort at Holiness is required on our part. (Faith without works is dead.)



(3) Because of the lack of Holiness and sanctification, we may not take some sins and temptations seriously. We may have mentally classified sin into that which is unacceptable with that which may be tolerated a bit. (It is the little foxes that spoil the vine in the Song of Solomon.)

Are we willing to call sin "sin," not because it is little or big, but because God's law forbids it? God has not called us to be like those around us, but to be like Himself.

If we are firmly grounded in the security of Christ, our motives will be pure. In striving to follow Christ in all areas of our lives, we will guard our bodies so sin and temptation does not reign within. The responsibility of resisting sin is ours. God does not do that for us. The potential for resisting sin is God-provided, but the responsibility for resisting sin is ours!

Resisting temptation produces a very overwhelming, but not an undefeatable, battle if we ask God daily to search our heart for sin that we cannot, or will not, see.

Standards are also where we go, the things we do, and what we say. Job said that he wouldn't suffer his mouth to sin (Job 31:30). And James said, If any man offend not in word, the same is a perfect man (James 3:2).

There are places that a Christian shouldn't go. It may not even be because it's a sin, but a stigma created in certain places and with certain games makes it a sin. Like shooting pool. There is nothing wrong or sinful about a pool-table. But because of all the evil encompassing pool halls, a stigma was born. Someone said, "It doesn't make any difference." Then why don't you ever hear of the Hells Angel's hanging out at the PING-PONG HALL?

Evil lurks in certain places and games, not necessarily because it is sin, but because of how it has been used.

Imagine a person free from pride, envy, greed, lust, and other passions. Would not that person find real satisfaction? But take away one virtue from his life, replacing it with one vice, and by that degree his happiness will be reduced. All trouble and uneasiness comes from lacking something or other. 

WE ARE NOT to remain children, except in malice (I Corinthians 14:20), but we are to grow up in Christ and finally become mature adults in Him. When children play they get their feelings hurt easily. If one won't let the other play with his little red wagon, he'll jump up and shout, "I'm going home, I'm not going to play with you any more!"

Is this not what some Christians do? Their brother or sister in the church says something to hurt their feelings and they may not be back in church for a month. They say, "No one in this church loves me, so I'll just stay home. That'll show them!"

An adult in Christ, on the other hand, is to be mature, complete which is nothing less than the standard height of Christ's own perfection. When someone hurts his feelings, he is to forgive that person seven times seventy, or four-hundred and ninety times, IN ONE DAY! (- even if that person does not ask for forgiveness. Remember, some offend others and don't even know it. Are we to let that person stand between us and God? If we do, that means he, or she, is closer to God than we are.)

#### WE MUST BECOME AS LITTLE CHILDREN

THE BED IS a picture of the CHURCH, and the covering is the WORD OF GOD. We must become as little children, and then we can fit under the covering of God and find REST (or PERFECTION) in the bed.

Leaven (sin) puffs up the flesh so the flesh can no longer fit beneath the covers, or even in the bed. For flesh is carnal and the church is Spiritual; the two will not mix. LOW is the way. It takes a straight and narrow pathway for one to fit into and become viable, living parts of the Church of Jesus Christ. We can secure perfection only by mortifying our flesh and becoming as little children.



Everything physical about us is like clothing. It is to be used; but with the using it will wear out. Our permanent (spiritual) part needs purity, our temporary part inclines toward pleasure. This is the internal war!

We are to consider our bodies as residences, keep them pure and clean. Considering your flesh as servants, give them enough food, rest, and clothing to do their duties. If you give your bodies more attention than this or your soul less, you are imprudent. Preferring adornment for the body over perfecting our soul is as foolish as preferring good clothes to good health. In short, cultivate your soul more than your body. Grow up, don't stay a little child!

THERE IS A big difference in Christ being in me and me being in Christ. When I received the Holy Ghost, Christ's Spirit entered me and forgave all my sins. The very next time I sinned I became a sinner. Before I came to Christ I was just an ungodly person, not a sinner. Paul said, For as many as have sinned without law shall also perish without law: and as many as have sinned in the law shall be judged by the law; For when the Gentiles, which have not the law, do by nature the things contained in the law, these, having not the law, are a law unto themselves: Romans 2:12,14.



Now a person can be in an organization and have Christ in him. To get Christ in you, Peter said, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost, Acts 2:38. However, as long as you are in an organization, you cannot be in Christ although Christ is in you. And as you cannot live in an organization and be in Christ, neither can you die in an organization and die in Christ at the same time.

When I found a Ministry teaching that I must quit the sinning business, I knew I had found the Body of Christ. Organizations do not teach this, therefore, they cannot be the Body.

As long as we are still sinning, however, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ, who propitiates, or pleads our cause, to His Father, and our God, that we might regain favour in His sight. John 1:9 says, He is faithful and just to forgive. Yet when we finally enter completely in Christ, we will sin no more. Righteousness will no longer have to be imputed, or just credited to our account, but it will be an intrinsic, ingrained part of us. We will be righteous through and through!

## THE THRESHINGFLOOR - OPEN PULPIT



#### CHAPTER VIII

THRESHING WAS the process of separating grain from the straw. Sheaves of grain were spread on the floor and trampled by OXEN that usually drew crude wooden sleds with notched rims (*Deut. 25:4*; *Isa. 28:27; I Cor. 9:9*). A shovel and fan were used in winnowing the grain (*Isa. 30.24*). Since robbers would visit the floor at threshing time, the laborers slept there (*Ruth 3:4-7*). Threshingfloors were often on hills where the night winds could more easily blow away the chaff.

#### ORNAN'S THRESHINGFLOOR

SATAN STOOD UP against Israel, and provoked King David to number Israel. This displeased God and He smote Israel because of this severe sin David had committed. Gad, David's seer (or prophet) came to David with the Word of the Lord, giving David a choice of three punishments because of this grave sin: (1) three years of famine, (2) three months to be destroyed before the enemy, or (3) three days of the sword of the Lord and pestilence in the land.

#### SPIRITUAL THRESHINGFLOOR

THE OXEN THAT trampled the wheat on the threshingfloor were bulls castrated so they could not reproduce themselves. This typifies the Ministry of God who are not to reproduce themselves. They are to care for God's flock, not their own. The Church does not belong to the Man of God, but to God.



The threshingfloor is the Church. Threshing are discussions of the Word of God and its meaning. Its vogue came about when discriminatory teachings began to circulate within the church. Jesus Christ, ascending back to the Father, left us with a plethora of dilemmas needing answers. Answers that only men of God striving to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bonds of peace can settle.

Without controversy, this can only take place in the Body of Christ, the Spiritual Threshingfloor. In fact, as King Solomon built the natural Temple on Ornan's threshingfloor, the Spiritual Church must be built on a Spiritual Threshingfloor.


